

Disaster Management Plan of Animal Resources Development, North 24 Parganas

A. Activities/ Activation of District DMAP(DDMAP):

- All possible measures for storage of medicines and biological products are to be made in the District Head Quarter and supply is being initiated to safe guard the livestock population in the district.
- Pre-monsoon mass vaccination against major livestock diseases in endemic zones is being taken in preparation.
- In connection with the procurement of balanced cattle feed in the event of natural calamities, the W.B Dairy and Poultry Development Corp. Ltd.(Govt. of West Bengal undertaking) will be requested to store and supply balanced cattle feed for the district as and when required.
- The Dy. Director, Agril. (Admin.) North 24 Parganas is being requested to keep ready a stock of paddy straw at the district and block seed firm for the relief purposes.
- Fodder paddy straw may be procure locally by the respective Blocks' Livestock Officer of A.R.D. with the concurrence of the District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas by inviting quotation and maintaining other official formalities.
- Prepare the vehicles for movement in the affected areas.
