

**NOTIFICATIONS REGARDING
BIFURCATION OF THE DISTRICT 24-PARGANAS**

The Calcutta Gazette, Extraordinary, Tuesday, February 18, 1986. Government of West Bengal, Land and Land Reforms Department : Land Revenue. Notification No. 212-L.R./6M-15/83-17th February, 1986—In exercise of the power conferred by the Bengal District Act of 1836 (21 of 1836), read with the Bengal District Act of 1864 (Ben. Act IV of 1864) and sub-section (2) of Section 7 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), and in cancellation of all previous notifications relating to the area included in the district of 24-Parganas and the boundaries thereof, the Governor is pleased hereby to create, with effect from the 1st day of March 1986, two districts named as North 24-Parganas and South 24-Parganas by dividing the existing district of 24-Parganas, the former having the headquarters at Barasat and the latter at Alipore.

The Governor is further pleased to direct that with effect from the aforesaid date, the limits of the district of North 24-Parganas shall include the local areas comprised in the subdivisions, and the police stations comprised in each such subdivision as shown in Schedule 'A' and the limits of the district of South 24-Parganas shall include the local areas comprised in the subdivisions, and the police stations comprised in each such subdivision as shown in Schedule 'B'.
