- 2) If proper signature and photograph is not uploaded at the time of online application that application shall liable to be cancelled.
- Applicants must be in possession of all the certificates and documents related to their qualification before the due date of publication of advertisement.
- 4) Applicant will upload the following supportive documents in one file (PDF) at the time of online application along with post wise required documents.
- The age proof certificate like admit card/school leaving certificate issued by the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education or similar board.
- Caste Category Certificate in case (SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B). In case of OBC applicants category 'A' or 'B' must be mentioned specifically in the caste certificate otherwise the candidate will be treated in "Unreserved" category.
- Passport/ Voter ID Card/ AADHAR Card/ Driving License proof of address.
- Photo proof identity card (Passport or Voter ID card or AADHAR Card or PAN Card)
- Experience Certificate if applicable.

- All applicants will fill up / enter the Final year marks of all Essential and Desirable/ preferential qualifications
 as required and upload positively.
- 5. Age relaxation will be applicable as per SC, ST, OBC-A and OBC-B categories.
- 6. Computer Education Marksheet/ certificate/ documents should be submitted as per requirement.
 - **7.** All the experience certificate issued and stamped by the appropriate authority starting from oldest to latest.
 - **8.** Experience will be calculated after obtaining the required qualification for any post as mentioned for any post as mentioned above, till the last date of online application.
 - 9. No objection certificate from the employer may be given if possible.
 - 10. The Higher Secondary (10+2) percentage of marks will be calculated as per the norms of the Council or equivalent Board Marks will be calculated on the basis of 2 languages and 3 compulsory elective subjects (Total 5 subjects) only as per marks sheet of the Council / Board, whichever applicable.
 - **11.** University Marks in case of Graduation and Post-Graduation will be calculated on the basis of marks obtained in all the University Examinations.
 - 12. Candidates will be called for Computer Test and Interview on the basis of score of desirable and essential criteria (wherever applicable).
 - 13. Candidates qualified in computer test will be called for Interview (wherever applicable).
 - 14. Place of posting may be changed as per the vacancy or requirement at the time of joining of that particular post.
 - **15.** The recruitment process including scoring for the different posts will be done as per the relevant Terms of Reference (TOR) issued by the Competent Authority which is applicable for that particular post.
 - **16.** Wrong entry in the online application (lower marks or higher marks), any mismatch with the originals, applications will be treated as cancelled during any stage in the selection process.
 - 17. In case of any anomalies or discrepancies found with the requirements or originals of the applicant, the Competent Authority may cancel the candidate in any stage of the selection process even and after selection.
 - 18. During the recruitment process, if new vacancy is created in any post, selection of the candidate will be made from the panel prepared from this Recruitment notification.
 - 19. For selection, the decision of the District Level Selection Committee, Vide Memo No. HFW/NHM-521/New/5840(6), dated 30/12/2022 regarding the recruitment is final. The approved panel (for the concerned post) will be valid for one year from the date of signature of the Chairman, DLSC.
 - 20. Application fees of Rs. 100/- for Unreserved category and Rs.50/- for Reserved category (SC/ST/OBC-A & OBC-B) must be given for the above-mentioned posts through 'Online Payment Getaway' at the time of online application. Without payment of application fees, the application will not be accepted. Application fees will not be refunded under any circumstances.
